The Filipino Food Movement (FFM), in partnership with the Philippine Consulate General in San Francisco, Philippine Consulate General in New York, the Philippine Embassy in Bern, Switzerland, Department of Trade and Investment Center in Silicon Valley (PTIC) and the Department of Tourism (DOT), announces the launch of Filipino Food Month, a month-long celebration showcasing the rich and diverse culinary heritage of the Philippines. Throughout April, FFM encourages diners to experience the vibrant flavors and cultural traditions of Filipino cuisine.

Established in 2018 through Presidential Proclamation 469, Filipino Food Month aims to spotlight the unique fusion of flavors, cooking techniques, and ingredients that make Filipino cuisine genuinely remarkable. The series of events will feature activities and programs designed to engage, educate, and delight food enthusiasts.
